RE: Regional Demonstrations

Thank you for the opportunity to share our voting solutions in Durham. It was wonderful to see many of you at the IOG conference. We apologize that we were unable to answer all your questions. We will be demonstrating all of our products again at each regional demonstration and hope you can attend so we may have another opportunity to address any additional questions you may have.

We will be demonstrating the ePollbook, the iVotronic RTAL, the Model 100 Precinct Optical Scan Tabulator, the Model 650 High Speed Optical Scan Tabulator, and the Automark Voter Assist Terminal. We will also be demonstrating our election management software suite, UNITY. Unity is Windows XP compatible and is used to program all equipment as well as provide election results and reporting. We also offer Ballot on Demand (BOD) using an Oki Data C9300 laser printer. It can be used for in office absentee and provisional ballots. It will print up to a 17 inch ballot double-sided and a 19 inch ballot double sided in two passes.

We were unable to fully address the Model 100 Optical scan solution. The Model 100 Optical scan is a precinct-based solution. The PCMCIA card used in the Model 100 certified in North Carolina will handle a maximum of 18 precincts with up to 40 splits each and 99 ballot styles. If you intend to use this solution for early voting, and your county is larger than these specifications we have several options:

1. you can use more than one PCMCIA card and swap the cards in one Model 100 without closing and reopening;
2. you can use more than one Model 100, each with a PCMCIA card programmed for the maximum 18 precincts;
3. you can use the Model 650 high speed optical scanner which does not have these limitations;
4. you can use our iVotronic RTAL which does not have these limitations.
